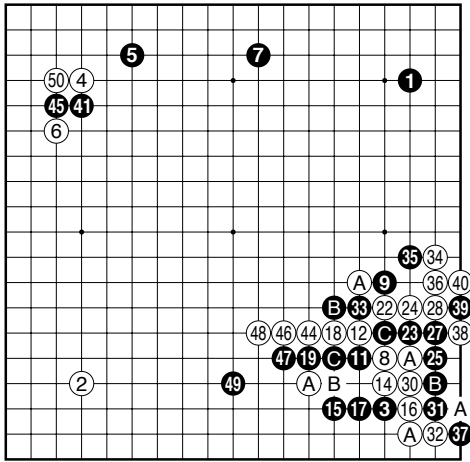


Figure 1 (1-50)

Black 15 this joseki depends on a ladder

Black 19 both A and B are joseki, if white plays A, black will cut at C

Black 25 A is correct, B is a mistake

White 40 dont throw in at A...

Black 41 white cannot answer the ladder breaker or the game is over...

White 42 This white A is really a new move... (it does not even appear in 21st century new openings :-)) before white played B

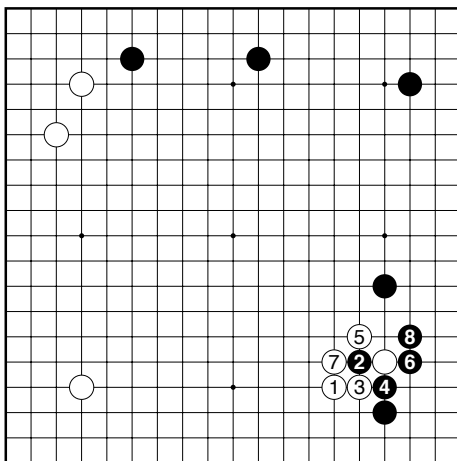


Diagram 1 (1-8)

Black 8 good for black, the marked stone is inefficient

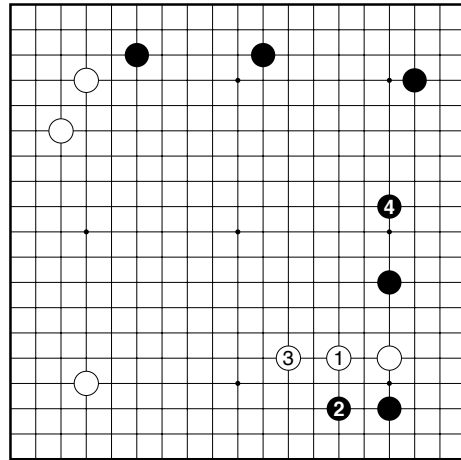


Diagram 2 (1-4)

Black 4 white is a bit slow... black has managed to play on both sides

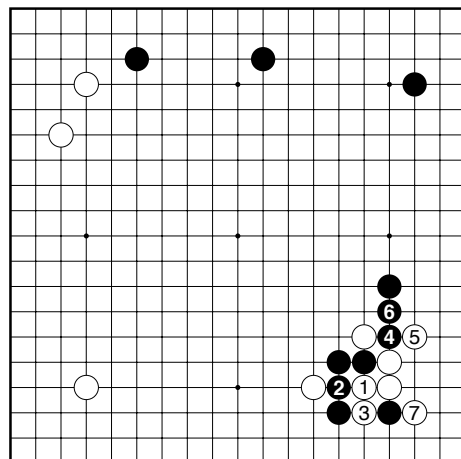


Diagram 3 (1-7)

White 7 black thickness is superior to whites profit

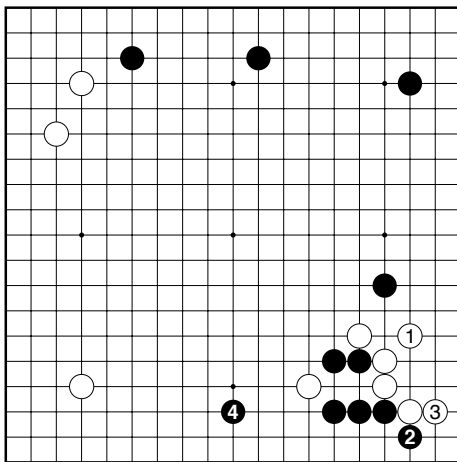


Diagram 4 (1-4)

Black 4 later

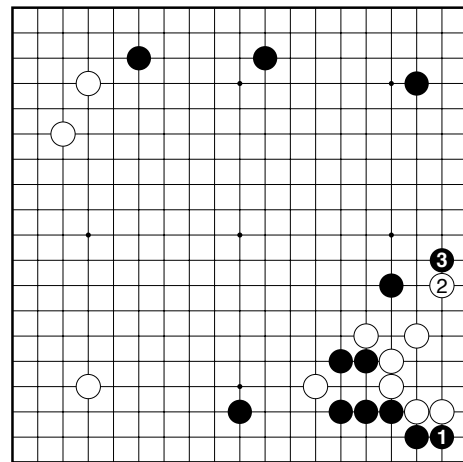


Diagram 6 (1-3)

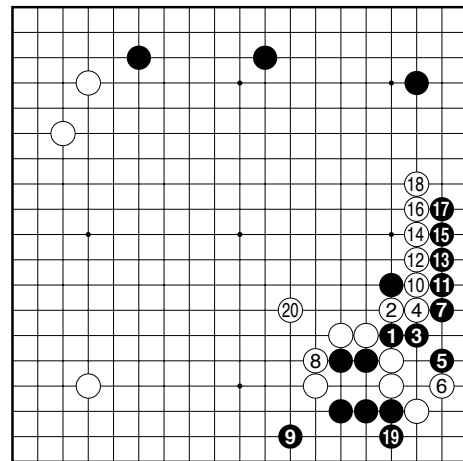


Diagram 7 (1-20)

White 20 good for white

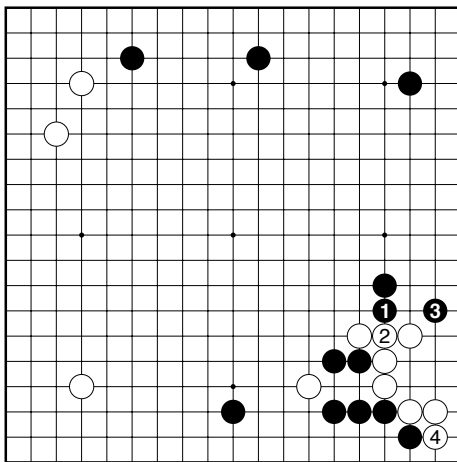


Diagram 5 (1-4)

White 4 white is almost obliged to answer

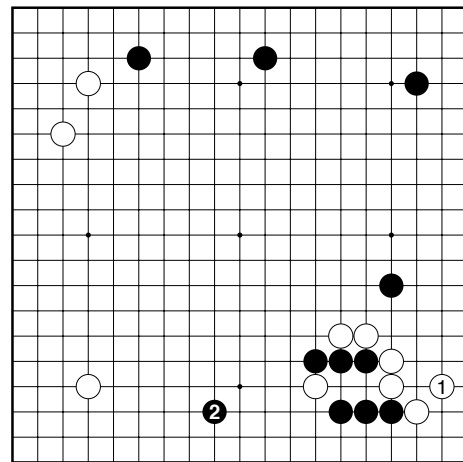


Diagram 8 (1-2)

Black 2 joseki

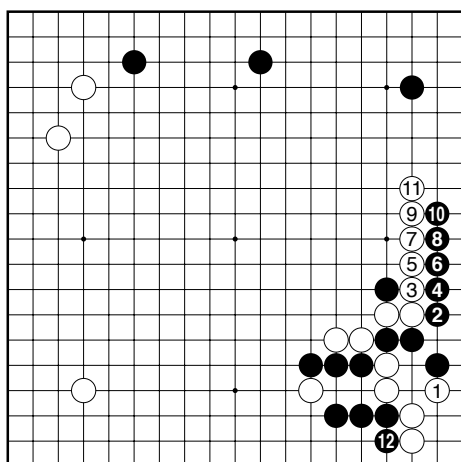


Diagram 9 (1-12)

Black 12 good for black

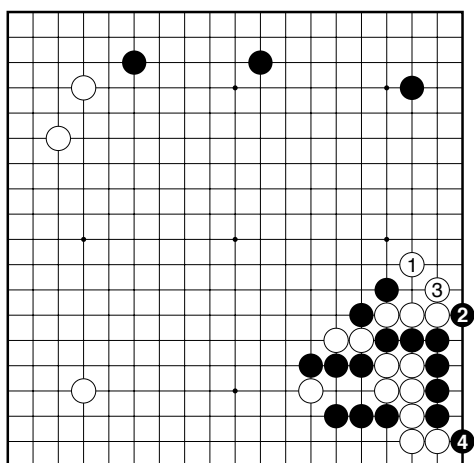


Diagram 10 (1-4)

Black 4 two hane is one liberty.... now white is dead

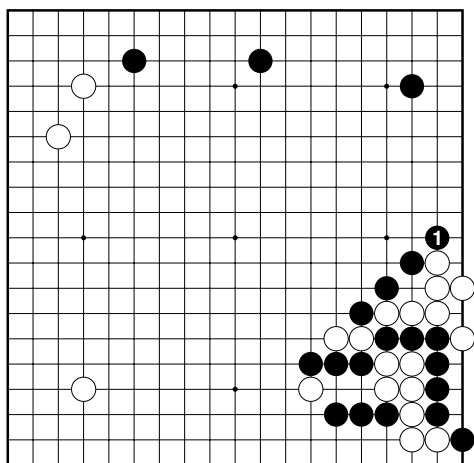


Diagram 11 (1)

Black can also play here and capture white...

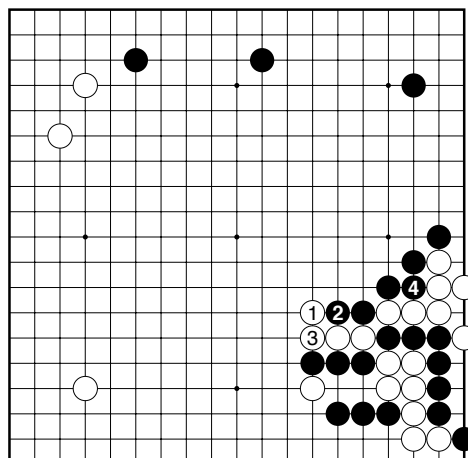

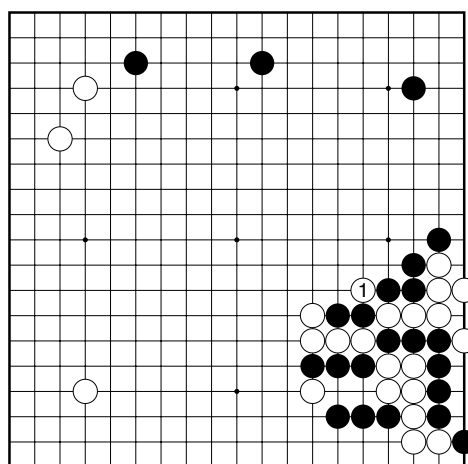

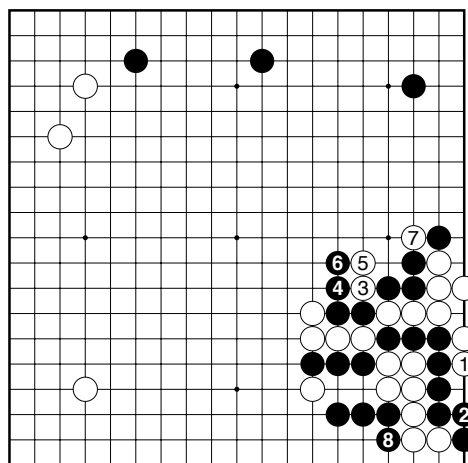


Diagram 14 (1-8)

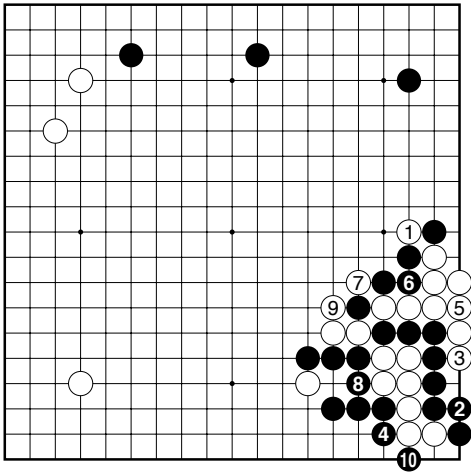


Diagram 15 (1-10)

Black 10 ... but white is think...

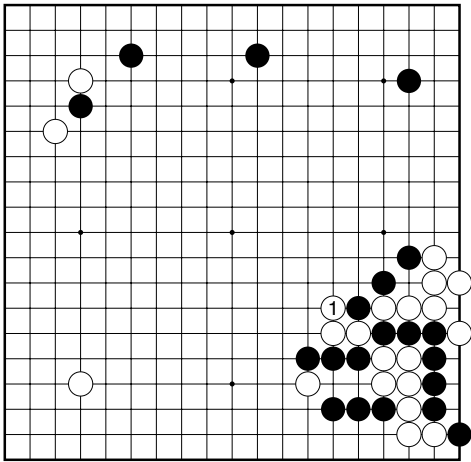

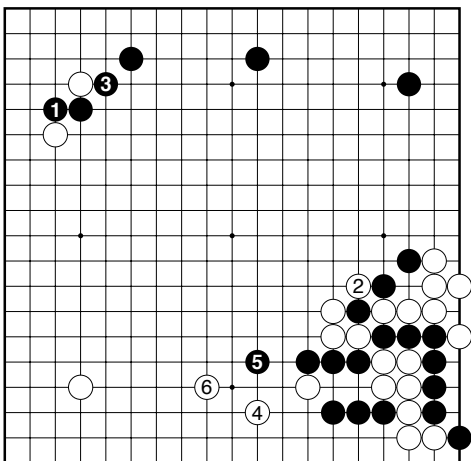


Diagram 17 (1-6)

White 6 was believed to be joseki (5 years ago), now considered good for white

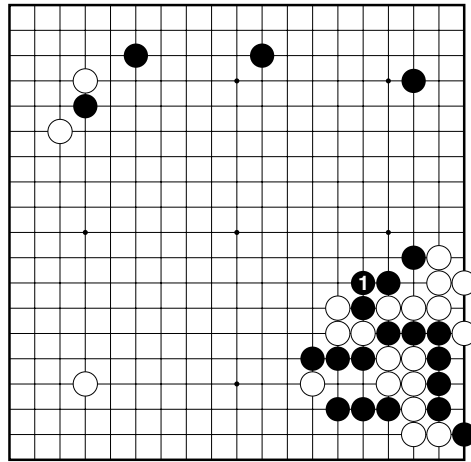

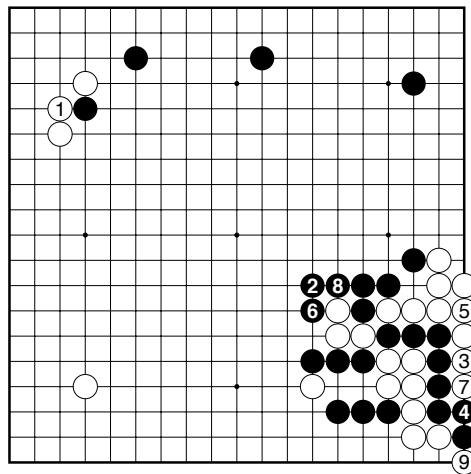


Diagram 19 (1-9)

White 9 good for black

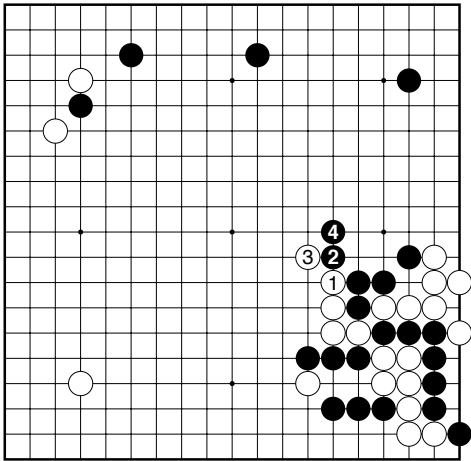


Diagram 20 (1-4)

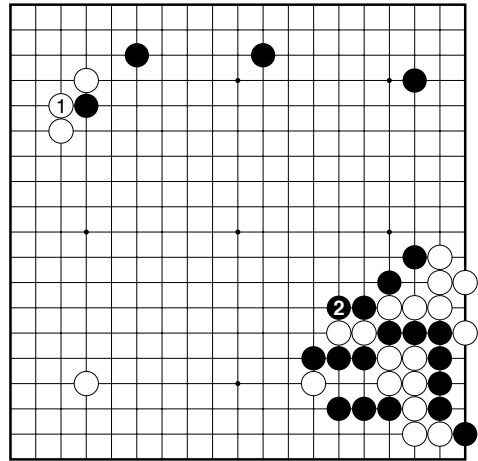


Diagram 23 (1-2)

Black 2 game over

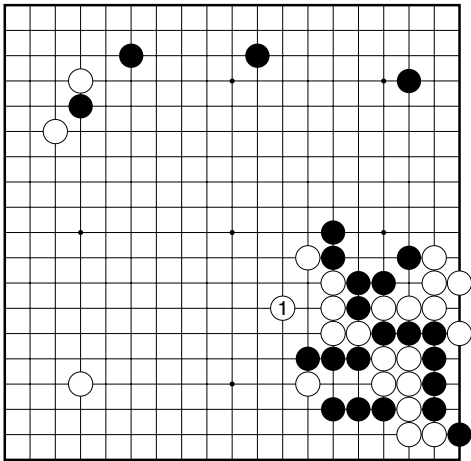


Diagram 21 (1)

now white is not so strong in the center

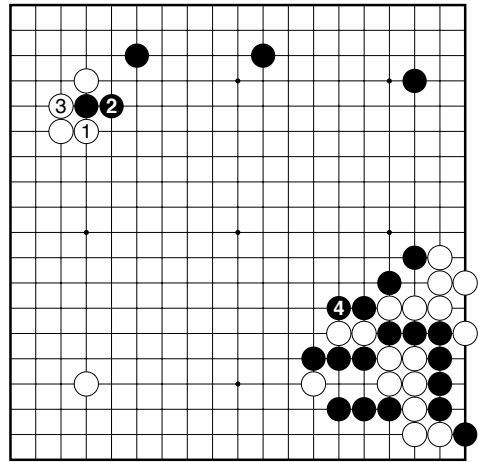


Diagram 24 (1-4)

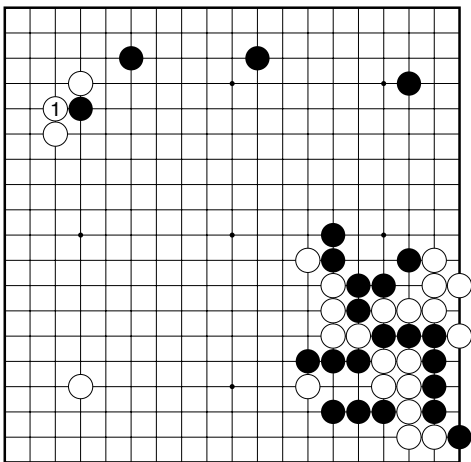


Diagram 22 (1)

no black has good moves at A and B

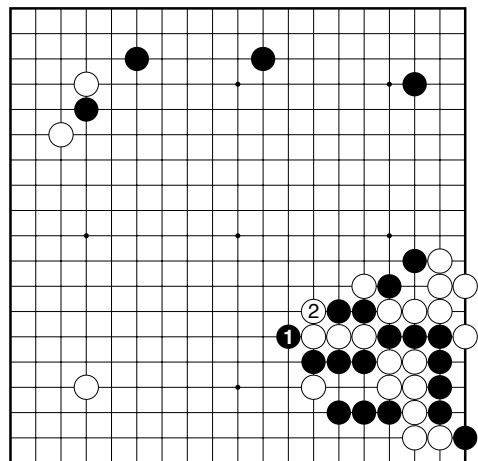


Diagram 25 (1-2)

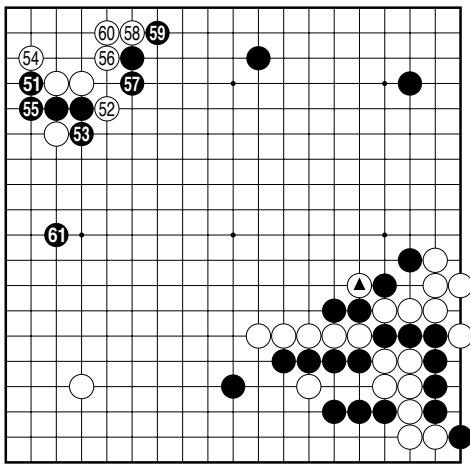


Figure 2 (51-61)

Black 61 normal opening the marked stone is a new move black cannot cut

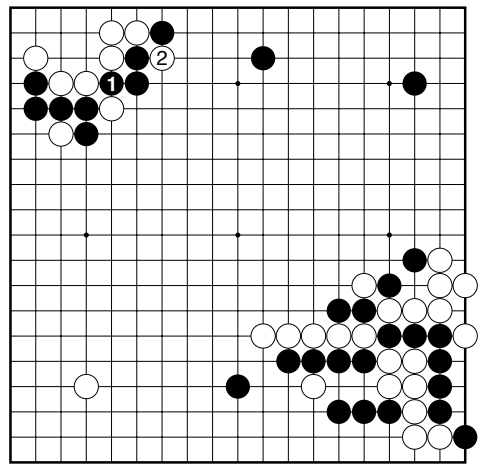
